NEXT STEPS

3 What does it look like for a parent to embitter a child? Why do you think the author specifically directs his comment to fathers? How can we overcome this challenge?

TOUGH: Where in your work do you struggle to do so wholeheartedly? Are you consciously doing your work for God? What would be different if you were?
