GOSPEL REFLECTIONS

Reflection Questions:

1. After some intentional time in the Word and prayer, is there something the LORD has made clear to you yet you hesitate to act? Why do you think that is?
2. Think back over this past year in particular, what reasons can you think of for times in which you have not followed the Lord's leadership? Would you consider these legitimate reasons or excuses? How do you know?

Next Steps:

- * **Small Step:** Choose a passage to read from Matthew chapters 5-7 (The Sermon on the Mount). Is God using your chosen passage to prompt you to obedience? If so, what might the typical excuses be for dismissing His prompting? Ask God to help you overcome excuses in your own life and decide on a step of obedience today that you've been avoiding.
- * **Big Step:** Consider beginning a prayer journal. Take some time to review the first three sermon passages of this series (Genesis 3:8-24, Genesis 18:16-33, and Exodus 3:1-4:17). How do these interactions with God effect your view of God? How does it affect or inspire what you pray for? Record these thoughts in your journal.
